

1-109 Communications from the Board

Communications from the Board to members of the Legislature, the press and the public should, whenever possible, be transmitted by and through the Chairperson of the Board. Inquiries in regard to matters upon which the Board has taken, or probably will take a position, should be referred to the Chairperson. Members of the Legislative Affairs Committee may also assist with these communications as appropriate.

There will be cases when an individual member of the Board will feel obligated to answer inquiries. In these cases, the member of the Board expressing an opinion as to matters upon which the Board has taken a position should support the position taken by the Board or make it perfectly clear that he or she is expressing a personal opinion that has not been approved by the Board.

This policy applies to Board members. The Chief Executive Officer is responsible for managing the communications of FTF staff with the press and the public. Communications of FTF staff with members of the Legislature is governed by Policy 1-110.
